**Supported Operating Systems** 



## Introduction

20-20 Technologies Inc maintains an operating system support policy that reflects Microsoft's own lifecycle policies wherever possible.

In the past, we undertook a series of development activities for 2020 Design that resulted in successive Microsoft compatibility certifications. To maintain Microsoft certification, we conducted a series of test cases to determine which operating systems are capable of supporting 2020 Design version 11.

As a result of this testing and consistent with Microsoft's policies, 2020 customers may need to upgrade their operating system before installing the latest version of 2020 Design.

In addition, we provide only limited MAC support under specific operating conditions.

## **Summary**

A diverse cross section of test cases was selected to provide maximum coverage.

The following table summarizes the status of all tested Microsoft operating systems against the currently maintained versions of 2020 Design.

A reasonable sample of tests cases was executed using the most recent preview edition of Windows 10 (v10.0.10145). No issues specific to that context were identified.

Based on these test cases, 2020 Design appears to function at least as well on Windows 10 as on any other supported environment.
